Sufi Music Festival, Nagaur - A Divine Dialogue

Poised in the middle of the majestic land of Rajasthan, the little known district town of Nagaur is best described as a place where many historic eras coexist. The magical fort of Nagaur is also known as Ahichhatragarh Fort. This impressive Fort, on the edge of the Indian Thar Desert, was created over a period of 800 years.

From a mud fort in the 4th century to a stone structure in the 12th century, to dilapidation in the 20th century, the Nagaur Fort has weathered all the adversities of time, history, romance, ambition and much more. Today after the completion of the architectural work under a comprehensive conservation program since early 1993, under the management of Mehrangarh Museum Trust, the fort reconnects with the magnificent grandeur of the medieval past.

The Nagaur Sufi Music Festival will mark the conclusion of the restoration project and serve as a step towards preservation and promotion of the unique heritage of this region - its architecture as well as the living and vibrant manifestations of its culture, arts, music, dance and the oral traditions.

The 3-day Nagaur Sufi Music Festival will take place from 16th to 18th February 2012 at Nagaur Fort. The Sufi music enthusiasts can soak in the live performances by Muezzins of Istanbul and various famed artists presenting Gombojorge & Diphonic singings, Koomij & nomadic songs, Sufi poems and Ottoman court music, Qawwallis, traditional music with Ney flute, tanbur, sato & dotar and Sufi songs and singings. Not only this, the participants will also get a feel of yoga, traditional dance of Teratali, Kathak and dance workshops. The artists would be coming from various places including Mongolia, Pakistan, Iran, Tadjikistan, China and Morocco.
