Coronavirus Update - 3

Countries around the world are stepping up efforts to tackle the coronavirus that originated in China's Wuhan city.

The first isolated suspected case in India of coronavirus, reported on February 10, 2020 has tested negative in fresh tests conducted on the patient in the southern state of Kerala. The patient had returned from the Wuhan University in China where she was studying.

Following the negative test result of the patient in Kerala, the 'state calamity' alert, declared by the Government of Kerala on February 3, 2020 has also been withdrawn with no fresh cases of the infection being detected.

The Ministry of Health (MoH) has issued a revised travel advisory in wake of novel Coronavirus outbreak and said extending visas, including already issued eVisa, are no longer valid for any foreign national travelling from China.

Thermal screening has been installed at all major international airports in India, including those in Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, and Cochin.

At present the travel business in India, Nepal and Bhutan remains unaffected by this current epidemic and our guests continue to follow their scheduled itineraries. We continue to monitor the situation and will update you as and when required.
