## Coronavirus Update – Nepal

Nepal's Ministry of Health and Population has issued a travel advisory to its citizens as well as tourists as a precautionary measure to prevent the spread of the deadly coronavirus.

The government has additionally suspended the visa-on-arrival facility extended to the nationals of France, Spain and Germany from 13 March, 2020 till further notice.

Last week Nepal had suspended visa-on-arrival for the nationals of People's Republic of China, including Special Administrative Regions, Islamic Republic of Iran, Italy, Republic of Korea and Japan.

However, those willing to visit Nepal can obtain visa by submitting an application beforehand accompanied with a recent health certificate.

Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu has been designated as the only entry and exit point for people arriving from these 8 countries.

The security measures remain active at the Airports, Borders and Hospitals and a special Task Force team is actively overseeing the situation under the direct supervision of the ministry of health.
