## Coronavirus Destination Update

The coronavirus cases have continued to rise in the region; however, we are seeing destinations gearing up for the new normal. There is gradual ease of restrictions with added precautions and decision-making is to be reviewed in keeping with the epidemiological pattern of the disease.

## **BHUTAN**

The Bhutanese borders continue to remain closed to tourists, all schools/institutions are closed, all bars/nightclubs are closed and all businesses have to be closed by 7 pm and social distancing norms continue to be encouraged.

The coronavirus case count in Bhutan is the lowest in the Indian subcontinent and now stands at 28 cases, with 6 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. There are no cases of community transmission and no death is reported due to the virus.
