Coronavirus Destination Update

SRI LANKA

Sri Lanka announced resumption of civilian life, and state and private sector activities in mid-May with curfew in place in Colombo and Gampaha districts. This week, the government has expressed hopes that curfew could be relaxed by 25 May to bring normalcy to the entire country. All passenger flight & ship arrivals into Sri Lanka remains suspended since March 22.

The coronavirus case count in Sri Lanka now stands at 1028 cases, with 584 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. There are 9 deaths reported due to the virus across the country.
