### Coronavirus Destination Update

The coronavirus cases have continued to rise in the region; however, we are seeing destinations gearing up for the new normal. There is gradual ease of restrictions with added precautions and decision-making is to be reviewed in keeping with the epidemiological pattern of the disease.

#### **SRI LANKA**

This week, Sri Lanka issued a comprehensive set of guidelines on resumption of Public activities as they gradually exit from existing restrictions focused on the “new normal” with timelines on when most activities can resume. The document notes bars/taverns and nightclubs, zoo and museums will remain closed, functions of preschool will be postponed and until further notice. All passenger flight & ship arrivals into Sri Lanka remains suspended since March 22.

The coronavirus case count in Sri Lanka now stands at 1469 cases, with 732 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 10 deaths are reported due to the virus.
