Coronavirus Destination Update

As countries gradually exit lockdown to reopen economies, the region is striving to find a balance to control the spread of coronavirus.

BHUTAN

The situation in Bhutan remains unchanged, as the border remains closed to tourists. Bhutan has continued to keep the coronavirus cases contained. The government continues to mandate strict quarantine measures, emphasis on contact-tracing, physical distancing in communal areas and restrictions on public gatherings. Educational institutions remain closed until further notice; work from home is encouraged in many government and private offices.

The coronavirus case count in Bhutan now stands at 67 cases, with 24 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. There are no cases of community transmission and no death is reported due to the virus.
