Coronavirus Destination Update

BHUTAN

The Bhutanese government announced new prevention and safety guideline effective 1 July, as they look to resume economic activities in the country. Government agencies are back to work in office. All sport and recreational centers (stadiums, gym, yoga/dance studios, etc.), parks and public areas have reopened. Businesses will resume with extension of closing time till 9 pm. The public has been advised to limit religious functions and social events to family members and close circle of associates. However, the Bhutanese borders remains monitored and closed to tourists.

The coronavirus case count in Bhutan now stands at 70 cases, with 34 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. There are no cases of community transmission and no death is reported due to the virus.
