Coronavirus Destination Update

There is gradual resumption of economic activity in the region with added precautions and decision-making is being reviewed in keeping with the epidemiological pattern of the disease. With ease of restrictions, the coronavirus cases have continued to rise in the region and we are seeing new guidelines being readied in destinations to gear up for the new normal.

SRI LANKA

The Government of Sri Lanka announced a comprehensive set of guidelines on resumption of Public activities as they gradually exit from existing restrictions focused on the “new normal” with timelines on when most activities can resume. The Island’s main international airport remains open only to service repatriation and cargo flights. However, a Presidential taskforce on Covid-19 has recommended reopening the airport from August 1, 2020.

The coronavirus case count in Sri Lanka now stands at 1749 cases, with 836 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 11 deaths are reported due to the virus.
