Coronavirus: Destination Updates

The coronavirus case count in India now stands at 1,040,948 cases with 6,53,750 recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 26,273 people have died due to the virus, however, the recovery rate is at an all-time high of 63.33%.

India's Covid-19 tally has crossed the one million mark with spike in the number of cases each day, however, recovery rate is at an all-time high too, fatalities is at 2.57%.

INDIA

India's daily testing capacity per million population has increased consistently to 9270 now. A cumulative total of 1,34,33,742 samples have been tested so far. The per day testing capacity, which was around 1,50,000 end of May, is nearly 4,00,000 per day now, The WHO in its 'Guidance Note on Public Health Criteria to Adjust Public Health and Social Measures in the Context of COVID-19' has advised comprehensive surveillance and testing for suspected cases and the need to conduct 140 tests per day per million.

Maharashtra continues to be the worst-affected state and has reported a total of 2,92,589 cases and close to 11,000 fatalities. The government, meanwhile, announced that a record 20,572 patients recuperated from Covid-19 in the last 24 hours and the country's recovery rate rose to 63.24%. This is the highest rate of recovery so far, according to the health ministry. Aggressive testing, timely diagnosis and effective management of patients either through supervised home isolation or active medical attention in hospitals is thought to have led to a surge in recovered cases.
