### Coronavirus: Destination Updates

#### **NEPAL**

Nepal's government has ended the national lockdown on 22 July, 120 days after it was imposed to control the spread of coronavirus but with few conditions, including continued ban on large gatherings. The government also announced the resumption of international and domestic flights beginning August 17, following the safety protocols for entry, which is to be advised. The country's international borders will also reopen the same day.

In line with the decision, hotels and restaurants will be allowed to open from July 31; however, they will be barred from hosting parties and gatherings. The government also opened Trekking and mountaineering activities from the day.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 18,094 cases with 12,684 recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 42 deaths are reported due to the virus.
