Coronavirus Destination Update

NEPAL

As the Covid-19 cases continue to surge, the Nepal Government announced the decision to extend lockdown till July 22 in its current form, where limited business and activities are permitted to operate.

The government on June 15 had changed the format of lockdown by allowing businesses to open following rules of social distancing, private vehicles on odd and even number basis, and passenger limitations. Educational institutions, religious places, gyms, bars, and other places of recreational activities will remain closed till the new extended deadline.

All domestic and international passenger flights to and from the country remain suspended until July 22.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 14,519 cases, with 5,320 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 31 deaths are reported due to the virus.
