Coronavirus: Destination Updates

NEPAL

Three weeks after lifting the lockdown, the Nepalese government has given local administrations and governments the authority to decide on restrictions and lockdown measures as Covid-19 cases continue to rise in the country. 284 new coronavirus cases and 8 deaths were recorded in the last 24 hours. According to the Ministry of Health, 51 have died since the nationwide lockdown was lifted on July 21.

The Nepal government has decided to restrict domestic and international passenger flights as well as long-distance transport services until August 31. While the Tourism Ministry plans to allow tourists to visit Nepal with less hassle, the entry guidelines for tourists are yet to be finalized.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 24,432 cases with 16,728 (68.5%) recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 91 (0.4%) deaths are reported due to the virus.
