Coronavirus: Destination Updates

SRI LANKA

The recently concluded general election saw Sri Lanka elect a new government to govern for the next five years.

Recognising the safety protocols introduced by the government of Sri Lanka, it was recently endowed with the World Travel and Tourism Council's (WTTC) Safe Travels stamp. It is among the latest destinations and the first in South Asia to begin using the world's first ever global safety and hygiene stamp. With all aspects of a traveller's visit thoroughly evaluated and necessary safety protocols put in place, Sri Lanka is expected to restart operations of the tourism and hospitality sector for international visitors.

The coronavirus case count in Sri Lanka now stands at 2,881 cases with 2,638 (91.6%) recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 11 (0.4%) deaths are reported due to the virus.
