Coronavirus: Destination Updates

NEPAL

The authorities in Nepal's capital Kathmandu have extended the prohibitory orders for another week until September 9, in view of the increasing cases of COVID-19 in the valley's three districts.

The Nepal government extended long-haul public transport and domestic flights restrictions until September 16. However, Nepal has allowed limited international flights' operation from September 2. Initially, only Nepalese and representatives of diplomatic missions, the United Nations and development partners will be allowed to fly into Nepal. The daily arrivals have been capped at 500 individuals. Those arriving will be required to show a valid polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test showing negative for COVID-19 taken within the past 72 hours. Nepal's land borders remain closed to foreign nationals until at least September 16.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal stands at 42,877 cases with 24,207 (56.5%) recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 257 (0.6%) deaths is reported due to the virus.
