

Coronavirus: Destination Updates as on 21 December 2020

NEPAL

Tourism Update: Nepal has opened its international airspace for regular tourism from 17 December. Land borders remain closed for movement of international tourists. Visitors will have to undergo mandatory seven-day hotel quarantine. Travellers will also need to carry a Covid-negative certificate of tests conducted 72 hours prior to their departure from their home country. No such report is required in case of children below 5 years of age.

Statistics: Number of cases reported in Nepal stands at 250916 cases with 238569 cases of recovery. 1743 deaths reported as on 17 December.
