



Coronavirus: Destination Updates as on 21 December 2020

SRI LANKA

International Arrivals: Sri Lankan airspace is opening up for commercial and charter flights with its first charter flight expected to arrive at Mattala International Airport on 26 December. This will be the first phase and will operate as a bubble. Colombo Airport is expected to open for commercial flights during the 2nd or 3rd weeks of January 2021. Strict regulations and safety protocols will be in place and guests will need to undergo mandatory seven-day hotel quarantine in ministry-certified safe hotels.

Statistics: The coronavirus case count in Sri Lanka stands at 34737 cases with 25652 recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 160 deaths reported as on 03 December.
