INDIA

FULL STEAM AHEAD

With the vaccination drive in full swing, India is leaving no stone unturned in preparing to welcome foreign tourists in the near future. The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India is deliberating a plan to resume inbound travel after recent discussions with top industry stakeholders. The government is in the process of outlining guidelines and standard operating procedures for international tourists visiting India on a fixed itinerary involving pre-booked hotels and domestic flights.

Guests will need to book their fixed itinerary journeys through a recognised tour operator for the duration of their visit. They will either have to present a vaccination completion certificate or a Covid-19 negative test report at least 72 hours before scheduled travel. They can also get the Covid-19 test after arrival at the airports where the service is available. As of now, the international commercial flight ban remains extended until 28 February 2021. We will keep you updated as this develops.

Restrictions on movie theatres, swimming pools, schools, and other public areas have been eased. By next month, more relaxations will come into effect. Domestic tourism saw another boost with many people heading out on mini breaks during the Republic Day long weekend. As many organisations continue their Work from Home policy, remote working vacations or "workations" also continue to be in vogue. The country is also making great strides in fighting off the virus and Andaman and Nicobar Islands has become the only state/Union Territory in India to be coronavirus free as on 03 February 2021!
