

Destination Updates as on 4 February 2021

NEPAL

In a bid to boost the morale of the tourism industry ahead of the spring season, the government of Nepal is considering unrestricted access to vaccinated tourists into the country. As of now, quarantine, insurance, and testing protocols for international travellers remain unchanged. Tourists originating from countries with new Covid-19 variant must undergo strict 10-day quarantine at their own cost at hotels enlisted by the Ministry of Culture, Tourism, and Civil Aviation. However, the industry is in talks with government authorities regarding relaxation of these rules to revive tourism.

Nepal has been allowing soft tourism, trekking, and hiking expeditions for foreign visitors since 17 December 2020. Land borders of the country remain closed. Please <u>click here</u> for the latest statistics.
