SRI LANKA

The Indian High Commission in Sri Lanka has recently submitted a proposal to the Sri Lankan Foreign Ministry and the Tourism Ministry seeking to restart flights between the two countries. With both countries keen to resume travel under the air bubble arrangement, an amicable agreement could be well underway soon. Both countries want to follow strict health and safety protocols issued by respective governments and adhere to all entry requirements.

Since opening their international air space to foreigners on 21 January 2021, Sri Lanka has received 1682 tourists during the month of January (as per Sri Lanka Tourism Development Authority data). The data also revealed that the guests where from Ukraine, Belarus, and China. India is one of the largest sources of tourists for Sri Lanka, and reopening travel between the two countries will bring a big boost to tourism.
