

Destination Updates as on 18 March 2021

SRI LANKA

Vaccination drive is in full swing in the Emerald Isle with the country receiving 500,000 doses of Covishield vaccines from India. The distribution for the public has started from 27 February and health officials are hopeful for the future. The inoculation is also likely to improve the island's tourism prospect. The country opened its international borders in January with a list of protocols for testing and quarantine.

Sri Lanka Tourism, in a press release dated 5 March 2021, stated that they are in the process of drawing up a 5-year 'MICE Industry Development Plan' in collaboration with private sector tourism partners and airlines. This is part of their recent drive to tap into Sri Lanka's huge potential as a MICE destination.
