

Destination Updates as on 17 September 2021

SRI LANKA

International travel requirements and protocols for foreign tourists remain unchanged for fully, partially, and non-vaccinated persons. Since the Emerald Isle opened its borders, it has received in excess of 4000 to 6000 tourist per month. Guidelines for children travelling are also unchanged. 73 per cent of the adult population (20 years and above) being fully vaccinated and 92 per cent of the population receiving at least a single dose. With more vaccines now being available, the Sri Lankan government has set a target to fully vaccinate the entire adult population by end of September 2021.

On the account of rising cases of the Delta variant Sri Lanka's on-going lockdown in effect since 20 August, has been extended until 21 September. However, tourism is possible in the non-lockdown areas and restaurants and cafes that are not in such areas can operate with proper safety protocols. Cultural sites and national parks are also open to visitors.
