



Destination Updates as on 29 November 2021

SRI LANKA

As of the midnight of 28 Nov 2021, the Sri Lanka Government restricted the entry of travellers from South Africa, Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia, Zimbabwe & Eswatini (Swaziland). Any prior arrivals from these countries were subjected to on arrival PCR test and quarantine at Level safe & secure hotel. Sri Lanka has not detected the Omicron variant COVID-19 as of now.

India's flagship carrier Air India has resumed direct flights between India and Sri Lanka under the air bubble arrangement. The airline will operate two weekly flights from Delhi and three weekly flights from Chennai to Colombo. This will definitely help the country to rebuild its tourism industry.
