

Destination Updates as on 17 December 2021

NEPAL

With the upsurge of a new variant of the Covid-19 virus found in African countries and to control the transmission of that virus Government of Nepal has revised the travel advisory. As per the new guidelines, international travellers from <u>sixty-eight countries</u> need to hotel quarantine themselves for 14 days on arrival in Nepal. A PCR test would be conducted on the seventh and the fourteenth day during the quarantine period. If the report is negative on day fourteen, traveller/s would be allowed to travel. Travellers with a positive report would be sent to the government designated isolation centre or hospital. The list of countries would be reviewed and revised by the government every fifteen days.
