



Destination Updates as on 2 March 2022

SRI LANKA

Travelling to Sri Lanka just got easier. As per the [new guideline](#) by the Ministry of Health, fully vaccinated travellers are exempted from pre-departure COVID-19 PCR/Rapid Antigen tests from 01st March 2022. Additionally, children of 18 years and below will be considered 'fully vaccinated' if they have received at least one dose of a recognised vaccination two weeks before to departure.

All tourist visa requires a "Mandatory" local Health Insurance coverage to be purchased [online](#) or on arrival (costs US\$ 12 per person and has a cover of US\$ 50,000).

Tourists who have difficulty obtaining an online Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) will be issued an on-arrival ETA at the port of entry into Sri Lanka as an alternative channel.
