



## Destination Update as on 28 June 2022

### INDIA

India is fully open to tourists since March 2022 and we can slowly see travellers from across the world coming back. July and August is seeing the Europeans coming back for their summer holidays. Hotels are busy and bustling with travellers.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare last updated the [guidelines](#) for international travellers arriving in India on February 10, 2022. As per the latest guidelines, [countries](#) which exempt Indian citizens fully vaccinated with nationally recognised or WHO recognised vaccines are allowed for relaxation under certificate of completing 'full primary vaccination' schedule of COVID-19 vaccination. It is required of all international travellers to "self-monitor their health" for 14 days after their arrival. The wearing of masks and upholding social distance rules, however, will continue as before.

With additional routes being added by airlines like Indigo, SpiceJet, and Vistara to encourage regional connectivity, more cities are now accessible. As a result, domestic travel has recovered to 98 percent of its pre-COVID levels.
